


Churt Parish Council Newsletter December 2019

Village Notice Boards

I am sure that you will all have noticed the rather impressive new notice boards outside the village hall. These have been provided by Churt Parish Council with the support of the Village Hall Committee and Surrey County Councillor David Harmer's member's allocation. David is a constant source of support to Churt and the surrounding villages and on behalf of us all thank him very much.

Intended use of village notice boards

One of the boards is for the exclusive use of the Parish Council. The other is for church and village notices. This board has three panes, two of which will be open to the public. Only notices relating to Churt will be allowed and any from elsewhere will be removed unless authorised in advance. The boards will be regularly monitored and I would respectfully request all organisations to remove expired notices. Some organisations will have permanent notices displayed which is fine but please be aware that these may be covered on occasion, for a short time by notices for one off events- e.g, CADS. There is a third lockable pane which is for the exclusive use of St John's Church. We shall trial the use of the boards for three months and then review. The existing Churt W.I. board will remain during this trial period.

Car Parking outside St John's Church

It has recently become clear that cars are being left for considerable periods in the parking area outside the church. This is in clear contravention of the parking regulations which prohibit overnight parking at this location. Please ensure that no vehicles are left here overnight and the current ones are moved immediately. If the problem persists further action may be taken.
